<u>School Lunches:</u> All meals have to be booked in advance. The kitchen will not cater for children whose meal has not been booked by <u>9:45am.</u> Our online system allows you to book until midnight the night before, if you are unable to book online please ensure that you ring the school office by <u>9:45am.</u> The office staff will then book a meal for your child.

Please do not request lunches via email. The emails are not always checked regularly enough to make sure that any orders are placed in time.

Please be aware that if your child does not have a packed lunch or a meal booked by <u>9:45am</u>, the office staff will call or text parents/carers and ask them to bring a packed lunch to school.

Punctuality

Since coming back from half term there has been a noticeable increase in children coming in late for school. The school day starts at **8.50am** with children starting their learning for the day shortly afterwards. We understand that things happen – roadworks especially at this time of year. However, It is really important that children get to school on time so they don't miss parts of their learning or disrupt the learning of others when they come into the classroom. For some children the thought of being the focus of attention when they arrive late is detrimental to their self esteem. If you are having trouble getting your children into school please contact school for assistance, Mrs Slater – our family support worker – is more than willing to help. The school gates will be shut at 9am, any child who is late after that point must be taken to the office and registered there. Thank you for your assistance in this matter.

Change of Uniform Supplier

Due to our current uniform supplier "Gooddies" rising their retail prices, we are writing to inform you that we will be changing the supplier of our school uniform from Gooddies back to Totally Uniform, who used to supply our uniform around 3 years ago. When undertaking this review, we focused on the quality and price point of the uniform, but also on the convenience and service. Totally Uniform is based in Kingswinford which will enable you to buy in person. Children can try clothes on in store and you will be able to purchase items there and then! If ordering online, you can select to collect from store for **FREE** or Home Delivery is charged at **£5.95** (Free over £50). Totally Uniform have a free 30 day returns policy, regardless of the delivery.

Since 1989, Totally Uniform has sat in the heart of the Community in Kingswinford for over 35 years supplying quality school uniform at affordable prices to over 50+ schools.

Totally Uniform will become the uniform supplier for Belle-Vue from **Friday 1**st **March 2024.**
